

Beach access:

To gain access to the San Onofre beach on April 6 and 7, you will need to take Interstate 5 to the San Onofre exit. Follow the signs for the state beach. Do not enter the San Onofre gate, as the road is washed out due to the recent rains. The road is closed past base housing, and it is also closed near the Trestles bridge due to the damage. Look at the map, and follow the Old Pacific Highway south. Turn west at the Beach Club Road. Follow the Beach Club Road north to the guard shack.

You will need to tell the Guard Shack that you are going on base as opposed to the state beach. Continue and park at the Beach Club, along the fence, or near the gate entrance at the playing fields. The Beach Club is the structure that is not a playgrounds, cabins, or shower houses. On April 7 there will be a lunch BBQ at the Beach Club after the brief service project is completed.
